S tatistically there are more women in the workforce in insurance than men.

This gender bias with more women in the back office is a reality across the board and not just in insurance. To further complicate matters in insurance there are more women in claims and less in underwriting.

And in what other ways can the insurance industry benefit from the increased presence of senior women?

The Summit will also discuss critical issues of women in insurance including prejudices against certain job types, gender bias, glass ceiling, salary gaps, mentoring and nurturing the female workforce.
